PROFILE

I am a London based art consultant facilitating private sales of blue- chip 19th and 20th century paintings – specializing in modern, impressionist and postwar art. I have an extensive international network of art market professionals, private collectors, museums, auction houses, galleries, art lawyers, conservators, and other specialists.

I studied art history and art business at Christies, Sotheby's and City Lit for a few years after my career as a TV presenter and public speaker.

I have always had a strong interest in arts, culture and music and have curated amongst others a major art exhibition by the Egyptian Calligraphy Artist, Ahmed Moustafa, and was the principal organizer of a multi culture multi faith concert in Sarajevo in 1998.

In the 1990s I was a leading presenter on MTV - and NBC Europe for nine years, created and hosted my own youth show in Germany for which I won several TV awards, including the prestigious Golden Camera Award. I also presented a travel show for Travel Channel and an Interfaith Show for Ebru TV.

I hosted a great number of music shows, corporate and cultural events as well as fundraisers and conferences.

In 2012 I published my best-selling memoir *From MTV to Mecca* in the UK with Arcadia and Awakening. Ullstein Verlag published the original German edition in 2009. Dutch, Arabic, Indonesian, Malaysian and Urdu translations are available as well.

I became a public speaker on topics such as Islam and the West, interfaith and Brexit.

Through my personal journey I have long standing friendships and contacts in Pakistan and in the Middle East, Turkey and Morocco.

Continuing with the art advisory service. We have also created a Whatsapp support group and organize special events for new Muslims

Spoke at a number of interfaith events from a European Muslim perspective and gave a speech about Prophet Muhammad's compassion and mercy to a charity in West London.

Brought a business delegation to Pakistan sourcing investment and cooperation opportunities and arranged high level meetings with government and private sector decision makers in Karachi, Islamabad and Lahore. I have been engaged in the development of those projects till the covid pandemic and look forward to be picking up again afterwards.

Honoured to conduct the Opening Ceremony of the Global Donor's Forum 2018 in London with HRH Sheikha Aisha Al Thani and presented the Award Ceremony at Mansion House in the presence of Alderman Alison Gowman and the First Lady of Turkey, HE Ermine Erdogan.

I spoke at the IOD Lord Mayor's 'Business of Trust' event at Mansion House on the Islamic perspective of ethics in business.

The Media Ministry of Saudi Arabia generously invited me to perform the Hajj and give media interviews to channels around the world and post on social media throughout. They kindly chose me as the only female keynote speaker during the Hajj Closing Ceremony in Jeddah, which was broadcast around the

Muslim world. I was also selected to address the Emir of Mecca during a press conference. A video we produced in Mecca featuring me at the Holy Mosque, the Haram Sharif, went viral and surprisingly received over 13m clicks withing days. I was honoured to be the keynote speaker at the City of London Eid event at London's prestigious Guild Hall and also at Interfaith Iftar Events at Harrow and Hounslow Mosque. I spoke at the Convert Circle at Central London Mosque, which I helped creating a few years previously and at another event to inspire the youth. I also chaired the Telegraph conference on Institutional Sexual Harassment – *Are Institutions Silent Witnesses*? for a #metoo campaign. The German Embassy UK asked me to interview the artists of the art exhibition HUMAN.

At the German Embassy moderated 'In Conversation' with the British Abstract Artist Frances Blane and Syrian artist Darin Ahmad, hosted by the Ambassador. I also interviewed Artist Kimberley Gundle at the German Embassy. Mrs Ammon, the ambassador's wife, kindly invited me to present my book at the German Embassy to a group of Ambassador's wives. I also enjoyed speaking to students at Eton College, followed by a lengthy Q n A.

With the charity organisation Muslim Hands went to Pakistan to support their *Honouring our Mothers* campaign. We visited hospitals and other projects in Lahore and Karachi and on our return, participated in TV and live fund- raising events back in the UK

Hosted numerous charity fundraising events and spoke to different Muslim communities especially throughout Ramadan. In June I enjoyed speaking at the international law firm 'Herbert Smith Freehills' Diversity Event. In May I was the keynote speaker in Chicago at the Sound Vision Conference.

In April I chaired a number of sessions at the Prestel and Partner Family Office Forum in Wiesbaden. I also performed at the Southbank as part of the Immigrant Diaries- Changing Britain Shows. I chaired the LISA Islam on Trial – Islamophobia conference in London where I was also one of the keynote speakers. I enjoyed visiting Pakistan's Rahim Yar Khan and its surrounding areas with the charity Save an Orphan where I helped distributing food, spoke to various communities and back in London participated in TV fundraising throughout Ramadan.

In March spoke at the House of Commons in London in front of various MPs and community leaders on 'British values and Islam'. In February I was part of a panel at SOAS discussing 'Pakistan beyond the Headlines and Homeland'. SoundVision asked me to be the key note speaker at fundraising events in Chicago, Dallas, Houston and Dayton speaking about the qualities of Mercy and Compassion exhibited by Prophet Muhammad when attacked.

In December 2014 was honoured to tell my journey to Islam to 9000 people at the MAS Conference in Chicago. I also joined a SoundVision fundraising tour through several US cities as key note speaker. In October I was invited to the House of Lords conference in London about the plight of the IDPs in Pakistan, and I moderated the Prestel and Partner Family Office Forum at the Dorchester Hotel. I moderated the Sami Yusuf album launch with a q n a session in London's Cadogan Hall in September. I presented my book in Pakistan at *the Iqbal e Dagestan* hall in Lahore, LUMS University and other venues across Pakistan. In February, I was humbled to be honorary speaker at North Eastern University, Boston and in January I toured South East Asia, speaking to sell out audiences in Borneo, Singapore and at the University of Hong Kong where I joined the was speakers at a conference exploring Religion and Power.

Had the opportunity to present my book at several UK Universities: Cambridge, Oxford, SOAS, Liverpool and Portsmouth and I gave key note speeches at several interfaith events throughout the country. I chaired the Cambridge University launch of the 'Narratives of Conversion to Islam' Report in London at SOAS and hosted several Mawlid events and Graduation Ceremonies.

My book From *MTV to Mecca* was published in English by Arcadia and Awakenig in September and I did a great number of book talks throughout London and the rest of the UK. In December 2012 I was humbled to speak in front of 16,000 people at the RIS Convention, Canada. I gave the key note speech at the 'Legacy of the Torch' Event held at Eton College and chaired a discussion at the House of Lords on the Arab Spring with Prof Tariq Ramadan. I spoke at the Congress of Leaders Of World and Traditional Religions in Kazakhstan, gave the opening speech at the think tank FIRD in London before the US First secretary as a 'friend of Pakistan' and also addressed FIRDS's student body about 'How to achieve success and awaken the inner giant'. I spoke at several University ISOC events about Muslim issues. I also hosted an event for Takeda in Budapest.

I presented the 'Reise' show on Travel Channel Germany for three years. I chaired the 'Hier and There' Cultural Event for the German Embassy in London as well as a panel discussion on 'Euro Islam' with Prof Tariq Ramadan for the Conference Beyond Multiculturalism- Islam in Europe at the University of Westminster (Konrad Adenauer Stiftung). I spoke to interfaith groups around the UK and Germany, hosted the Pakistan Achievement Awards in London, chaired a Radical Middle Way debate on *Islam and the environment*, launched the

Muslim/ Swarovski fusion artist Nurjan at the Mica Gallery in
London, and hosted the EMWI Awards in Madrid. I spoke on
Muhammad's environmental teachings at Warwick University
and on a Common Identity at an Integration Conference at the
German Reichstag as well as moderating the Allegria Festival in
Hamburg amongst others.

I became the presenter of the travel program 'Reise' for Travel

Channel, and of the interfaith magazine 'Matters of Faith' for Ebru TV. My autobiography: From MTV to Mecca was published in Common by Hillstein World

in Germany by Ullstein Verlag.
